"Since 1982, the average snowfall in Les Saisies is greater than in the surrounding mountain ranges and more or less the same as 10 years ago: 458 cm of snow last winter compared with 324 cm in 2014-2015. The resort boasts an average of more than 120 skiing days per season and, according to the 2022 Climsnow survey, snow is guaranteed in Les Saisies until 2050. The resort boasts a microclimate and excellent artificial snowmaking facilities. The fitting of height measurement tools to all our snow grooming vehicles enables us to produce exactly the right amount of snow. Year after year, we gain in snow management expertise, adapting our working hours according to weather conditions."



THE FLOCON VERT CERTIFICATION, AWARDED ASSOCIATION MOUNTAIN RIDERS IN 2023. IS A RESULT OF THE RESORTS COLLECTIVE COMMITMENT TO SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, **ECOLOGICAL. ECONOMIC** AND SOCIAL TRANSITION.

The SIVOM des Saisies, the villages of Hauteluce and Villard sur Doron, the SAEM Les Saisies Villages Tourisme and the SPL Domaines Skiables des Saisies are collectively committed to the protection and promotion of the region's natural and cultural heritage through 4 key actions:

- To control urban development and land artificialisation.
- To decarbonise activities, promote soft mobility and encourage energy renovation.
- > To diversify activities in 4-season mode.
- To enhance local life and prompt active civic participation.







> Stakeholders: The creation of a charter of committed professionals to raise awareness, federate and promote.

> Farming: The creation of an environmental observatory for pastoral activities to facilitate exchanges between farmers and ski area management. Measures include water sharing and the limitation of transport via water tankers.



Activities: The promotion of green activities such as the use of electric snowmobiles, electric sleigh rides and eco-conscious trapping adventures under the **Explora Project.**

A WORLD CHAMPION BREEDING GROUND

Three young champions began their careers in Les Saises. Before achieving success on the international circuit, they trained from an early age on one of the largest and highest-altitude Nordic ski areas. All three athletes will be representing France and the resort of Les Saisies at the **2026 Milano Cortina Olympics.**

- > Julia Simon, 29-year-old biathlete: ten-times world champion, Olympic vice-champion (2022) and crystal globe winner 2023, Julia is currently training at home in Les Saisies in preparation of the 2026 winter Olympics.
- **Justine Braisaz-Bouchet,** 29-year-old biathlete: five-times world champion and Olympic champion (2022).
- > Karl Tabouret, 22-year-old biathlete and cross-country skier, member of the French Handisport Team: double world champion in para-cross-country skiing (2025) and para biathlon (2024), Karl is also vice-world champion in para cross-country skiing (2025).

LE SIGNAL: SPORT. POOL & LEISURE COMPLEX

Ideal for both training and recovery, the Signal sports complex serves as base camp for the locally born international ski champions Justine Braisaz-Bouchet and Julia Simon. This 800 sq-m multi-sports facility and hypoxic chamber, which artificially recreates conditions up to 5,300 m altitude, is ideal for training purposes. For post training recuperation, the wellness complex boasts 3 Jacuzzis, saunas, a hammam and several treatment rooms. A pool complex, home to a 200 sg-m swimming pool, a hydro-massage circuit and 2 counter-current swimming lanes complete the facilities.


